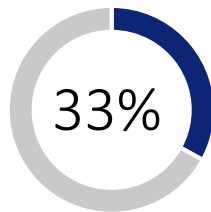


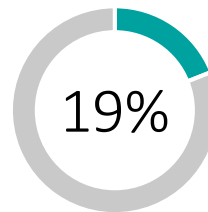

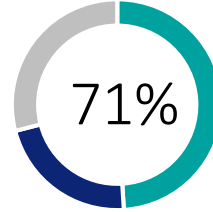
Farmworkers contribute to the U.S. Food Supply



Live in Poverty

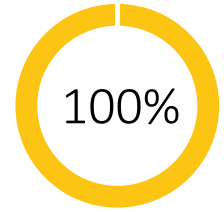


Migrants
